Alfred Rollo George (b. 1879), the couple separated PLEASE HELP subsequently re-married Florence Mary Darell in 1905 and their daughter Lady Elizabeth Blanche Mary Gordon was born the same year.^[1] Florence went on to have twins and a further daughter.

He was commissioned into the Royal Perthshire Militia in 1872 and later transferred to the Black Watch, with whom he fought in the 1882 Anglo-Egyptian War, and was awarded the Ottoman Order of Osmanieh. He resigned as a Lieutenant in 1883.
