in all areas, especially for Collectors today.

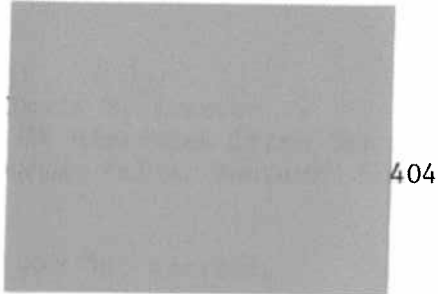
