
Colt, Model 1873 S.A.AHMY, CAL.. Colt Serial no. 81926 Artillery version. With Al Furstnow M.T. holster and belt as originally purchased from Joe De Saye of Turner Montana, Sold to Jim Wilson and bought back from Jim Wilson prior to his death. He probably owned it up to 8 or 10 years. But he retained the gun and belt set together. Trigger guard is #8659 Cyclinder is # 34 Butt is #II5I54 Barrel is #47972 Grip is I903 The date of 1903 would probably place the date as April I, 1903 as noted on the Colt letter for Serial number 114039 (letter enclosed). Serial no. 21926 was sent to Colt for outling the barrel to $5\frac{1}{2}$ from $7\frac{1}{2}$ inches and for refinishing. It was shipped back to Springfield Armory after Colt completed that contract of making it an Artillery Model in a lote of 200 guns on the date of 6-16-1903. Which guarantees the date of 1903 as noted on the left side of the wood grip or stocks. The original gun no. 47972 (barrel as noted above) was returned to Springfield Armory in a lot of 150 refurbished guns on 2-13-1903.

Our records also indicate Single Action Army revolver serial #114039 was one of a hundred Single Action Army revolvers that were returned to the Colt factory by the U.S. Government for refinishing and cutting the barrels from 7 1/2" to 5 1/2". This work was completed and the arms were returned to the Springfield (Mass.) Armory on April 1, 1903.
