### DESCRIPTION OF ARTICLE

#### LADY'S RING

An 18.75 carat aquamarine framed with diamond melees mounted in yellow gold having a gross weight of approximately 11.4 dwt. The piece is stamped "T-Z" and "18K". The stones are described as follows:

One rectangular cut aquamarine with dimensions of 21.0 x 13.80 x 9.15 mm estimated by formula to weigh approximately 18.75 carats; GIA clarity grade is VVS1; GIA color grade is estimated to be vs1gB 2.5/2 determined by using GIA Gem Set under a full Spectrum VITE-LITE; very good symmetry and polish.

Four 2.5-2.0 x 3.5 mm, four 2-1.5 x 4.0 mm and four 1.5-1.0 x 2.5 mm tapered baguette diamonds estimated by formula to have a total diamond weight of approximately 0.75 carats; twenty-four 2.3-2.5 mm full cut diamond melees estimated by formula to have a total diamond weight of approximately 1.25 carats; GIA clarity grades range from VVS1 to VS1; average GIA color grade is estimated to be G-I; very good symmetry and polish.
