STOCK MARKINGS/DECORATION: Extensively carved with relief panels.

REPAIRS/RESTORATION: Missing brass inlay at rear of tang; missing strip of brass inlay (1 1/2 inches long) on barrel.

HISTORICAL/ARTISTIC SIGNIFICANCE: Fine example of Italian gunsmithing at end of 17th century.

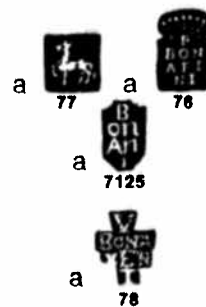
