Service Yesterday For W. L. Wright

Funeral service was conducted yesterday at St. George's Church by the Rev. John S. Haight for Wilfred L. Wright, chairman of the board of directors of the Sav-

age Arms Corporation, who died at his home on Cherry Valley road, West Hempstead, November 10 after a short illness. Born in Sioux City, Ia., 70 years ago, Mr. Wright received his higher education at Cornell University,

where he was graduated with the degree of Mechanical Engineer in 1900. He had been a resident of West Hempstead for many years. Mr. Wright was president of Savage Arms Corp. for 21 years, from 1919 to 1940 when he became

chairman of the board. At his death he was also chairman of the board of the Sipp Eastwood Corporation of Paterson, N. J. His clubs were the University and Uptown of New York, the Garden City and Cherry Valley Clubs of

Garden City, and the Wyandanch Club. He belongs to the Kappa Alpha fraternity. Surviving are his widow, Margery White Wright, and two sons, Craig L. and Hamilton W. Wright, and two grandchildren.
