

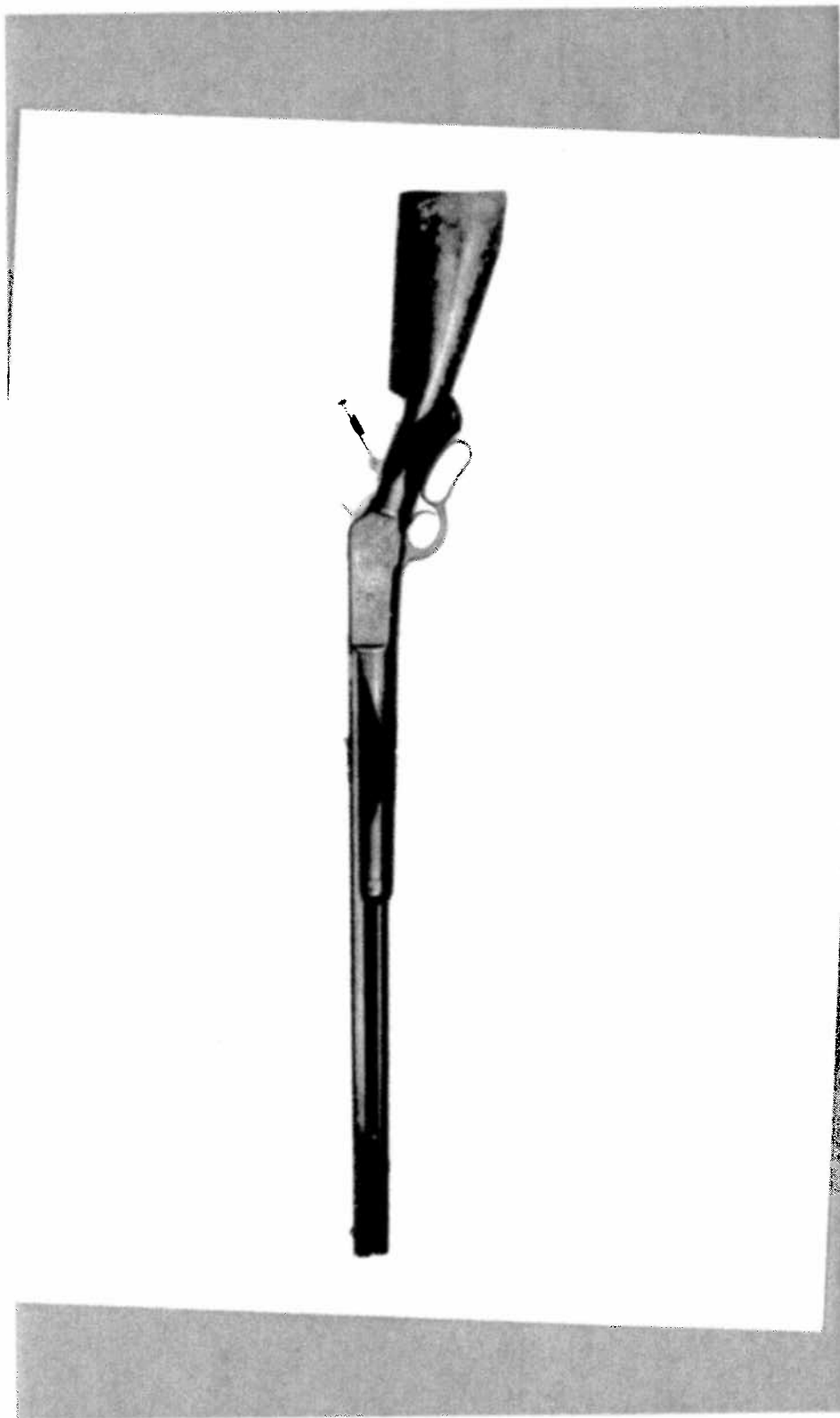

The Winchester Model 1873 serial number records list number 250187 as a rifle, caliber 44, octagon barrel, set trigger, sling and swivel. Casehardened, checked stock, engraved \$2, Beach and sporting leaf M/76 sights. Shipped September 28, 1887, no other information listed.

Model 1886, serial number 110270 is recorded as a rifle, caliber 50-100-450, octagon barrel, plain trigger, checked stock pistol grip, shotgun butt, matted barrel. Lyman hunting front sight. Engraved \$6, moose on one side, caribou on other and plenty of scroll work. It was shipped September 3, 1896, no other information listed.
