To whom it may concern;

I acquired a circa 1840-1850 wooden chest and contents from a collector, now deceased, in Bristol, VA approximately 13-15 years ago. He told me that it had come from an antebellum home in Bristol.

This chest contains the following items in the lower drawer:  
A pair of E. H. Rogers dueling pistols, Augusta, Ga.  
Accessories for the pistols.  
A whiskey flask.

The upper compartment with hinged lid contains a flappy neck gentlemen's white shirt with what appear to be blood stains. It has a name and date on the shirt tail, written in old brown ink. The chest also contains a circa 1830-1850 photograph in gutta serena case of a stately old gentleman wearing a similar shirt, and an old coverlet.

According to Richard Kennedy, a recognized authority on antebellum Georgia firearms, this is the only known pair of Georgia pistols.
