Seaver, Light Company 'C,' 8d Rhode Island Artillery, and with the same inflict a dangerous wound about the neck of the said Lieutenant, he being in the execution of his office. This at Beaufort, South Carolina, on or about the night of February 12, 1868.

To which charge and specification the accused, Private Michael Duffy, Company "C," 8d Rhode Island Artillery, pleaded "Not Guilty."

FINDING.

The Court, having maturely considered the evidence adduced, finds the accused, Private Michael Duffy, Company "C," 8d Rhode Island Artillery, as follows:
