Thank you for writing in regards to your A.H. Fox double barrel shotgun.

This past week, I was able to search the original Fox serial records and locate the record card that is particular to your double bearing S/N 302383. The record card tells us that your double was originally built as follows:


Grade-	CE grade
Gauge-	16 gauge
Barrels-	28", choked Modified(R) & Full(L)
Stock-	14"length of pull, 3-1/2" drop at heel
Weight-	6 lb., 2 oz.

This double was shipped from the Fox factory in Philadelphia, PA. on March 22, 1928. The original consignee is listed to be the Beall & Steele Drug Co. No address was provided.

The CE Grade Fox is considered a high grade shotgun. It is engraved with fine scroll and game scenes that were always popular and had a definite British style of quality and elegance. This grade could also be built to your own specifications with regard to barrels, stocks, triggers, ejectors, etc. Stocks could be specified in half or full pistol grip. A straight grip could also be had at no additional cost. The basic price for this grade in 1928 was \$107.30.

I hope this information is interesting and helpful to you.

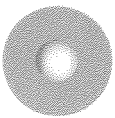
