

Daniel Fraser & Co #5076 circa 1991. A fine unused .416 Rigby ejector rifle built on a trigger plate " Blitz" action with 24 inch barrels with gold inlaid leaf sights for 50, 100 and 200 yards, ramp-mounted bead foresight, sight rib engraved " DANL. FRASER & CO. CROMARTY. THE BLACK ISLE, SCOTLAND ", automatic safety gold inlaid 'safe' , rolled edge trigger guard gold inlaid with the serial number, elongated top strap with beaded border, Best bold stylized acanthus engraving deeply carved on a matt background, the underside of the action engraved with the head of water buffalo, retaining virtually full original color-hardening and finish. Highly figured pistol-grip stock with engraved cap and trap, cheek piece and sling swivels measures 13 5/8 x 1 5/16 x 2 x 1/8 cast off to original thin 1/2 inch Wilson pad. Weight is 9-14. The rifle was commissioned by Bernard Horton, the owner of Daniel Fraser. Shot and regulated with 410 grain Federal ammo. The action was made by Mark Sullivan, ex Holland & Holland. The barrels were made by Holland & Holland. Donald Custerton did the stocking, finishing shooting and regulating. Engraving was done by Keith Spibey. A very fine double rifle with a most desirable caliber. \$42000
