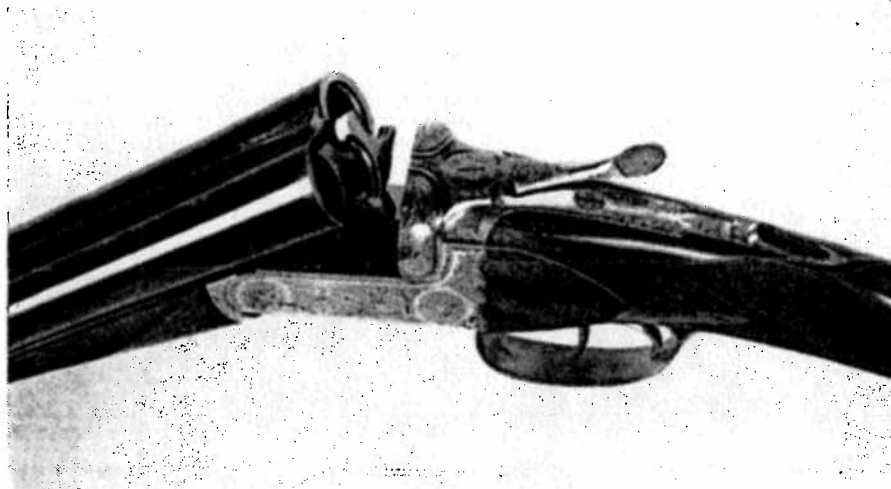

The new 1966 pattern Regal embraces every refinement in design and craftsmanship accumulated during recent years. The action body has been reshaped to a more classical pattern whilst the engraving has been developed with fine rosettes and scrolls.

The Regal has always been one of our most popular models both from the standpoint of quality and price. Sportsmen do not 'buy' a Regal gun, they 'invest' in one knowing that it will give a lifetime of good service and fine performance.

SPECIFICATION

- BARRELS:-** Special nickel steel, (XXV) 25-inch. or longer.
Note:- Whilst the majority of customers order the XXV model owing to its extreme handiness and lightness we are often asked to supply longer barrels and can maintain our high standard of balance with 28-in., although the weight of the gun is slightly increased.
- CHOKE BORING:-** To customers' requirements but for normal game shooting we recommend having the right barrel bored improved cylinder and the left barrel bored between quarter and half choke.
- ACTION:-** Churchill's special sturdy box lock pattern.
- CHAMBERS:-** Unless otherwise ordered all chambers are 2½-in. (70mm).
- STOCK:-** Matured French walnut selected for close grain and figure.
- WEIGHT:-** Please see overleaf for average weight of Regal guns.
 Made in 12, 16 and 20 bore.

The Regal gun is also available in a special Wildfowl model chambered for 3-inch cartridges with barrel lengths ranging from 25ins. to 30ins.

Notes on the "REGAL" Model



There can be no doubt that the Anson and Decley action satisfies a world-wide demand. Instead of separate lock plates, carrying their members as a self-contained unit, the body of the action is deeply slotted with a pair of grooves, each ample to receive the three principal limbs for effecting percussion:—(1) The Tumbler, (2) The Sear and (3) The Cocking Limb.

By means of holes passing transversely through the action, the Tumblers and Sear are pivoted on simple steel hinges running from side to side. Thus at a single stroke all the complicated works of the locks and the fitting of their plates, both into metal and wood, is dispensed with.

The action so planned and constructed, supplies a fit framework on which to express the ideas embodied in the "XXV" system, namely, short and sturdy barrels holding a maximum of the total gun substance at the axial level, a powerful but compact action, and, finally, ample scope for closely moulding the stock to the figure of the shooter. In combination these factors produce an easily handled and natural-fitting gun, which feels half-a-pound lighter than it really is, whilst offering to recoil what conveys the impression of a massive resistance.

As a model for hard and sustained use, oftentimes for years denied the benefits of skilled attention, it is unequalled. Complete enclosure at top and sides forbids moisture entry, yet when occasional oiling is needed its simple bottom-plate, held by a single screw, gives access to the working parts. The absence of lock-plates removes the temptation to dismount a component which ought never to be interfered with, except under dire necessity.

There are three points regarding this order which we must clarify. First the weight, if you want the gun proved for Magnum cartridges, and of course, 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " chambers the weight is going to be about 5 $\frac{1}{2}$.lbs. At the present time I cannot make a 28 bore weighing only 5.1bs.

Secondly, the barrels must be 26" in length and not 25".

Thirdly, I think you have specified too much bend or drop. I am sure you will shoot low with the 3" drop. I feel this should be not more than 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " at heel and 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " at comb. I am not sure how you took these measurements, but if they were taken from a gun with a ventilated rib you would naturally attain a 3" drop.

On receipt of your reply I will put the gun in hand, but delivery will take at least six months.

Pursuant to my letter of November 25th, and your reply of December 1st, I am pleased to enclose my order for your Regal model shotgun. I had assumed that the price quoted would have been somewhat less based on a price list I had received last year and the current devaluation.

I assume that the Regal model is made with automatic ejectors.

My order is as follows,

- 1- Regal model shotgun 28 bore 25¹/₂ barrels
