The grips have most of the original varnish. Overall the gun has 95% of the original bright blue. The casing is with the flattop lid with most of the original finish. Inside of case is fine with some fading of the velvet lining. The case is completely original, accessories include 28CAL single cavity iron bullet mold. Rare single plunger charger and a loading tool combining a rammer and worm. I've never seen a tool like this in a Paterson casing before but its size is correct and it fits. This exact set is pictured on the back cover of <u>Jackson Arms Catalogue No. 16</u> which is July 1960. The collection of Ben Ames Williams Collection was sold at that time. This set was part of his collection. Ben Ames Williams was an artist, editor, and writer. Two of his best selling books were House Divided and The Unconquered.

A fair price for this rare Paterson set would be \$130,000.


