Francotte 90963 was received in inventory at A&F on 4-27-70. It is described as a Francotte "Eagle" grade which is not correct. The retail price of 90963 was \$3150 while another Eagle grade on the same page was priced at \$1875. The only other information entered for 90963 is 20 gauge, 26 inch bbls, choked Mod & Full. In place of the name of the buyer is the entry "Not in Inventory" with no further explanation and no additional entries for the gun in later years. Stolen? Sent to Chicago or San Francisco and sold? The 1970's were not A&F's finest years.

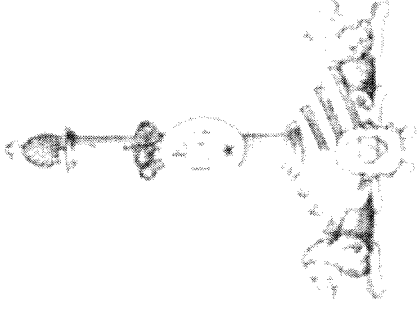
