Please send historical information on Colt New Line revolver, 41 caliber Rimfire, serial # 5025. It appears original and has a nickel finish, a gold wash cylinder and pearl grips inscribed "Annietta Mitchel" by a carved inscription on the left pearl grip. It is cased in what appears to be an original casing, contemporary with its date of manufacture. Do factory records show any of these features or was the engraving and casing and inscription done by the dealer.
