We just bought a collection of about 200 Colts, and all different; so I have enclosed a photo of a few that you might like to know about.

- ✓ #7076-Cloverleaf, serial number 1635 and factory engraved. The barrel is smooth and clean with traces of blue around the sight and quite a bit under the barrel. A nice light patina otherwise. The cylinder has some blue in the flutes and a light brown patina on the high points. Fine aged patina on the brass and sharp engraving. Quite a bit of blue on the hammer. The Walnut grips are excellent with most all the original varnish. Complete. \$495.00.
- ✓ #7070-New Line .41cf, serial number 7946. All I can say about this gun, is that it is about new, blue and case colors. \$295.00.
- #7075-Cloverleaf, serial number 7006 and with a 1 1/2 inch round barrel. The barrel has the small Colt on the left side. Smooth clean metal with a light patina and just traces of blue on the barrel and cylinder. Nice aged brass. The grips are German Silver. \$495.00.
- #7079-No. 3 Derringer, serial number 1261 with the hump under the frame. The barrel has just traces of blue in the protected areas. The frame has about 50% of the Silver, and the Walnut grips are very nice with about 85% of the original varnish. \$395.00.

We have lots of others, but these I thought, might interest you. Let me know.
