Second Lieutenant, Captain Conway's company, First Battalion, First Establishment, September 18th, 1776; Second Lieutenant, Captain Morris' company, First Battalion, Second Establishment, November 29th, 1776; First Lieutenant, ditto; wounded at the battle of Germantown, October 4th, 1777; resigned.
- SCHENCK, CURTENIUS. First Lieutenant, Captain Longstreet's company, First Battalion, First Establishment, December 16th, 1775; First Lieutenant Captain M'Mires' company, First Battalion, Second Establishment, November 29th, 1776; retired September 26th, 1780.
- SHELLEY, JOSIAH. First Lieutenant, Captain Bloomfield's company, Third Battalion, First Establishment, February 7th, 1776; resigned February 24th, 1776.
- SKELTON, JOSEPH. First Lieutenant, Fourth Battalion, Second Establishment, November 28th, 1776; declined; also First Lieutenant, militia.

Private, Captain Bloomfield's company, Third Battalion, First Establishment; cadet, ditto; Ensign, Captain Dickerson's company, ditto, July 19th, 1776; Ensign, Captain Dickerson's company, Third Battalion, Second Establishment, November 29th, 1776; First Lieutenant, ditto, November 11th, 1777; Lieutenant, Third Regiment; Captain by brevet; discharged at the close of the war.
