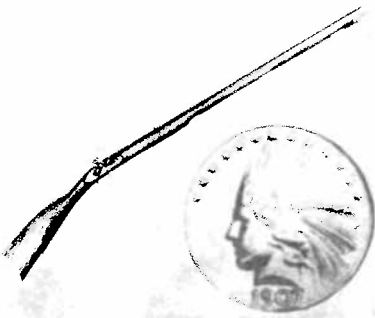
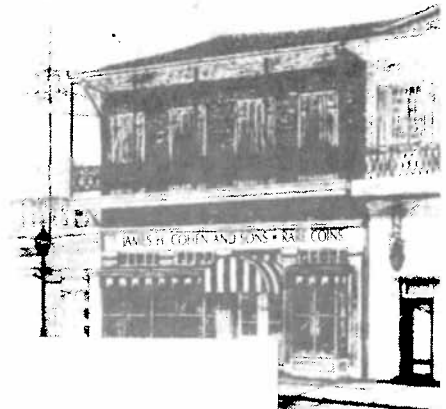

STEVENS/STEPHENS

James Gunmaker (Successor to Wattell Clark), 43 High Holborn, 1815-22. See Thomas Stevens (2). Succeeded by Thomas Stevens (3).

Thomas 3 Gunmaker (Successor to James Stevens), 43 High Holborn, 1823-42. Gunmaker to Prince Regent (trade label). Succeeded by Robert Braggs.

BRAGGS

Robert Gun & Archery Manufactory, 37 High Holborn, 1825-31; 36 High Holborn, 1832-42; 43 High Holborn (Successor to Thomas Stevens), 1843-7; 151 Strand, 1836-47. Also made stone cross-bows and published *A Short Treatise on Archery*, 1832.

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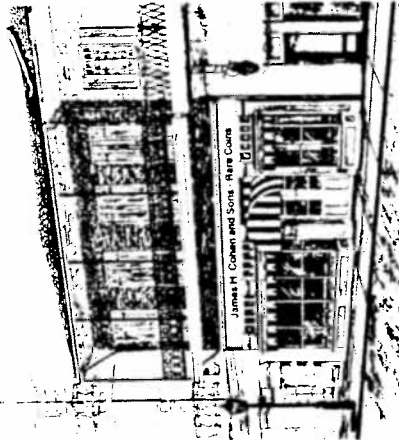
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
