Howdy, Craig. I hope all is well.

We took a look at the Model 1876 survey looking for identical to your SNs (8637 & 3568).

We did not find any other 1876s with identical configuration to SN 8637 (Carbine, Casehardened, Set trigger, Swivels, Nickel trims, & Sporting leaf sight). There were a few casehardened with nickel trims up near SN 60000 but the other configurations did not match.

~~*With SN 3568 we were looking for Rifle, Octagon barrel, Plain trigger, Pistol grip stock, Wind gauge and Vernier sights, Engraved and Plated. The only similar one we found was SN 16714 with Rifle, Octagon barrel, Plain trigger, Checkered stock, Pistol grip, Wind gauge and Vernier sights, Nickel, Engraved \$2.50.*~~

This was about an hour's work.
