Starting with an early 60's lightening in 98% original condition:

Jack Haugh fitted this piece of English Walnut and qualified the action metal with wood in place. He subsequently finished and checkered the wood in a standard Browning Exhibition pattern.

Jimmy Nixon engraved and inlaid 24kt gold in a pattern similar to a Browning Exhibition. Jimmy is a southern Missouri engraver that is little known as most of his effort is under contract to a higher volume importer of Perazzi shotguns.

Paul Fuchs, now deceased, performed all the metal polish and rust bluing including all interior action parts which are high polished similar to a Midas Grade. Paul was formerly General Manager of Browning's repair and restoration shop in St. Louis, MO.
