AFFIDAVIT

In July of 1974, I purchased from Romer Zane Grey, three firearms that were the property of his father, the world famous and renowned author, sportsman, and chronicler of the American West, Zane Grey. Romer was living in a modest home in Altadena having sold his father's estate in 1970. Romer had trunks full of Native American rugs and in among them were three of Zane Grey's personal firearms that he had given to Romer, his eldest son.

The three firearms were a Colt Single Action Army serial number 351971, a factory engraved Model 1895 Winchester, and the G Grade Parker 20 gauge serial number 149406, the subject of this affidavit. Romer stated that the Parker was Zane Grey's favorite bird gun and that he treasured it. Romer was more reluctant to part with the Parker than either the Colt Single Action or the more valuable Ulrich engraved Winchester M1895, which I sold to Chris Anderson of Fort Carson Antiques in the parking lot of Sotheby Parke Bernet Los Angeles. The Colt Single Action and the Parker G Grade serial number 149406 to Mr. Lewis Ferguson, owner of Ames Guns in Santa Monica, California in August of 1974.

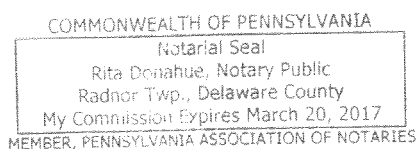

Dear Michael:

The .45 Colt Single Action Six Gun was given to me by my father in 1929. He got it either from Babbitt Brothers, or Switzer Hardware Company in Flagstaff, Arizona, some time previously.

I have had this gun with me constantly since it was given to me, wherever I could legally take it.

Wherever I rode horseback on hunting trips, I carried it in a specially built holster in the pocket of my chaps.

It felt rather comfortable to have it along when we were bear hunting in the bottom of some thicketed canyon where it was always possible to get in uncomfortably close quarters.
