COAT AND BOOTS USED IN HIS MOVIE "GORKY PARK"

Lee Marvin was unquestionably one of the top "tough guy", macho actors of the 20th century. Unlike many "tough guy" actors, Marvin was the real thing. He had been a US Marine and was badly wounded in action in the South Pacific.

After his stint in the Marine Corps, he became involved in television and movies and was in over 100 shows & movies between 1950 and 1986. He received innumerable awards for his portrayals, most notable of which was the Academy Award he won for his performance in "*Cat Ballou*".

This leather coat and unique pair of boots was worn by Marvin in the spy movie "*Gorky Park*". The coat bears the original label, "S. Style, AITOA N AHKAA". The movie was set in Russia but was actually filmed in Finland. This coat and boots were purchased by the production company in Finland for use in the movie. In this movie, Marvin played the character Jack Osborne, an investigator attempting to solve a triple homicide that purportedly took place in Russia. This 1983 Cold War thriller included William Hurt, and was nominated for a Golden Globe Award in 1984 and won the Edgar Award for Best Motion Picture and was nominated for a BAFTA Film.

The coat and the boots have come directly from his estate and were recently sold by his widow, Pam Marvin, who is still alive and lives in the Southwestern United States.

A copy of an affidavit signed by Pam Marvin attests that this coat and boots were indeed used by Lee.
