126,434 12/30 M/F Full pistol Silvers Pad ST rear position 2 Lyman sights 14" 3¼ Heel Sterlingworth E

John Lauterback Jan 24 1930

7200 No card

160,245 Sterlingworth Brush card stamped Skeet in several places Skeet cylinder 1 choke August 21 35

Dear Mr. Kidd:

Your Fox gun number 30067, has only the following information listed on the card found in the serial number records at the Savage factory. This was a grade "FE" 12 gauge gun with 32" barrels choked Full and Full. The stock had a half pistol-grip, pull of 14" and drop at heel of  $2\frac{1}{2}$ ". This gun weighed seven pounds five ounces. No consignee, nor date of shipment was on the card. I hope this information will be of interest to you.
