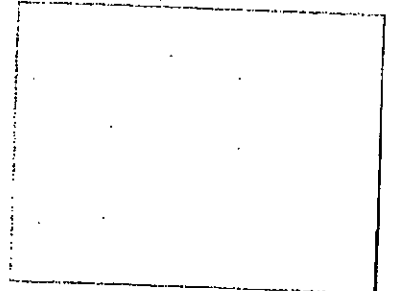

A.H. FOX SHOTGUNS CERTIFICATION OF ORIGINALITY

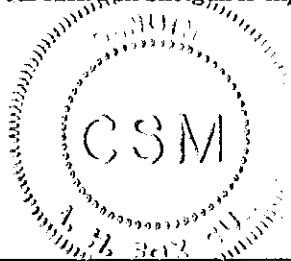
You have purchased the original A.H. Fox Double Barrel Shotgun. It is a gun of the same design that President Theodore Roosevelt carried with him when he sailed to Africa on his most publicized expedition in March of 1909. Later the same year President Roosevelt, commenting on his guns, wrote "I had a Fox No. 12 Shotgun; no better gun was ever made."

From the early 1900's to World War II, ten's of thousands of A.H. Fox Shotguns were manufactured. Today a great many of these early guns are still in use. For over 85 years the design of the A.H. Fox Shotgun has been tested, in the field, by generations of hunters and shooters.

The gun you have purchased is not a 'reproduction,' it is in all respects a genuine A.H. Fox Shotgun. It was manufactured in New Britain, Connecticut by the Connecticut Shotgun Manufacturing Company. The serial number of your gun was assigned sequentially by us from the point that production was halted in the 1940's.

Your gun was engraved and finished, by hand, in the United States.

With proper care, your A.H. Fox Shotgun is expected to last 'many lifetimes.'
