Dear Mr Adams

We are writing further to your request for information on Purdey gun no. 10332. The information we have recorded for this gun is detailed herewith.

This 12 Bore Double Barrelled Hammer Gun was the No. 1 gun of a pair.

1878

This gun was built with 30" barrels with top lever.

The length to the middle of the stock was 14 ³/₁₆" and the gun weighed 6lbs 12ozs.

The stocks were shortened to 13 ¹⁵/₁₆" but we have no date recorded for this.

There is a note in the dimensions book " 1926 - 10332 gave way on joint side. NOT marked Nitro Proof".

We do hope that you find this information of interest.
