W. J. Collins at Bridgeport Tenn. on the 1st day of August 1862 to serve for the term of 3 years He died at Clinton Tenn. on the 21st day of June 1863

The said J. P. Rodgers was last paid Paymaster H. Galt Capt + Adm to include the 30th day of April 1863 and has pay due him from that time to the 21st day of June 1863 He is due him commutation from the 3rd day of November 1862 to the 21st day of June 1863 on account of clothing not drawn in kind He is indebted to the Confederate States six dollars for clothing drawn in kind

Rogers who, after being sworn according to law, deposes and says, that she is the widow of James G. Rogers deceased, who was a Private of Captain Collins Company, Co. 55 Regiment of Georgia Volunteers, commanded by Col. B. B. Hawks

in the service of the Confederate States, in the present war with the United States; that the said James G. Rogers entered the service at Bridgeport in County and State of Tennessee on or about the 1 day of August 1862, and died at Clinton, Tenn on or about the 24 day of June 1863, leaving the dependent his widow's wife and that she makes this deposition for the purpose of obtaining from the Government of the Confederate States whatever may have been due the said James G. Rogers at the time of his death, for pay, bounty or other allowances for his services.
