This is to certify that I, David M. Ulrich, am the son of Leslie Borden Ulrich (1888 - 1966) and Esther Christian Ulrich (d. 1936), as well as the grandson of John Ulrich (1850 - 1924) and Esther Munsill Ulrich. I further certify that the firearm described below was originally owned by my father, Leslie Borden Ulrich and that it has remained in my family's possession until it sale today, the 6th day of July, 1998.

A Winchester Model 1892 Carbine, serial number 954730; .44-40 caliber; 20" barrel; receiver and barrel blued; butt and forestock of finely figured walnut. The receiver engraved by my second cousin Alden George Ulrich with game scenes (a bear and a hunter shooting an elk) set within scrollwork. The pistol grip of the buttstock and the forestock both chequered.

This carbine was originally made for Leslie Borden Ulrich, circa 1925 and engraved at the Winchester Repeating Arms Company factory by Alden G. Ulrich.
